


Discussion Deck: Asia capable school

- How is our school using ICT to support student learning in languages and studies of Asia? Are there possibilities to make Asia-focused content relevant and meaningful that have not yet been fully explored?
- 2. Are a range of online resources used to support Asiafocused curriculum across learning areas and levels? What opportunities exist to do so?
- 3. Is ICT used to connect students with their peers in Asia? What collaborative web tools (eg videoconferencing, wikis, Edmodo) are being, or could be, utilised?
- 4. Does our school use current ICT to support teacher collaboration and professional learning in Asia capability (eg online professional learning communities)? Is this effective? How could it be made more effective?
