



A Jakarta Jaunt

How to play:

1. This is a game for a minimum of two players. Players may play in teams or alone.
2. Each player needs a dice and one token.
3. Place the question cards in topic piles on the marked spots in the centre of the board.
4. Throw a six to start the game.
5. Move around the board in a clockwise direction and pick up a card at each stop.
6. Question cards are won when a player lands on a space and answers a question correctly from the related topic card pile:

R = Recreation

B = Shopping

S = History


A = Nature

J = About Jakarta

There are two spaces on the board where you can choose the topic ('You choose'); one space ('Windfall') where you can collect a card without having to answer the question; and one space, ('Penalty') where you have to hand back a card.

7. The game ends when all question cards have been won. The winner is the player who collects the most cards.
